For a late night haunt, Social provides one of the most ambrosial experiences downtown at such a reasonable price. Some of their small plates are exquisite and while their wine list may be full of puns like "My

Pinot is Bigger than Yours," it is diverse and extensive. We love their complimentary Normandy Farms bread served with whipped butter and tomato and olive tapenade. For wine buffs, Social also has trios of flights, centered around different tastes averaging around \$12.
